

# Crochet Heart



## Pattern Instructions

**Magic Ring:** Create a magic ring and make 6dc stitches into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to create a circle of 6 stitches

**Round 1:** ch1 and 2dc into the same stitch. 2dc in the remaining 5 stitches, join with a slip stitch to the first dc at the start of the round (12 stitches)

**Round 2:** slip stitch to next stitch, ch1 and 2 dc in to the same stitch. 2dc in next 2 stitches, 1dc, (1dc, 1htr), (1htr, 1dc) 1 dc, 2dc into the next 3 stitches. Slip stitch into the last stitch, then to complete the round slip stitch into the first stitch of the round below (this creates the dip for the heart) (18 stitches)

**Round 3:** ch 2 and 1dc, 1htr into 1st dc of the round below ( top of the heart) (1htr, 1tr),(2tr), (1tr, 1htr) 1htr in the next 4 stitches, (1htr, 1tr), (1tr, 1htr), 1htr in next 4 stitches, (1 htr, 1tr), (2tr), (1tr, 1htr), (1htr, 1 dc) slip stitch into the same stitch as the round 2. (28 stitches)

**Round 4:** ch1 and 1dc in to first dc of round 3. 2dc in the next 5 stitches, 1dc in the next 7 stitches, (1dc, 1htr) , (1htr, 1dc), 1dc into the next 7 stitches, 2dc in the next 5 stitches, slip stitch into the same stitch as round 2 (40 stitches)

### Finishing

#### To make an individual heart:

Make a chain long enough to hang the heart and slip stitch into the back of the heart to create a loop and darn in the ends with a tapestry needle

## Info

This pattern is to crochet a heart. It can be used individually or made into bunting by crocheting the hearts evenly along a foundation chain

## Materials

Yarn and appropriate sized hook

## Tension

Tension will depend on the yarn and hook that you have used

## Techniques

Magic Ring  
slip stitches  
chain stitches  
double crochet  
half treble crochet  
treble crochet

Increasing stitches  
Make 2 stitches in one stitch from the row below
